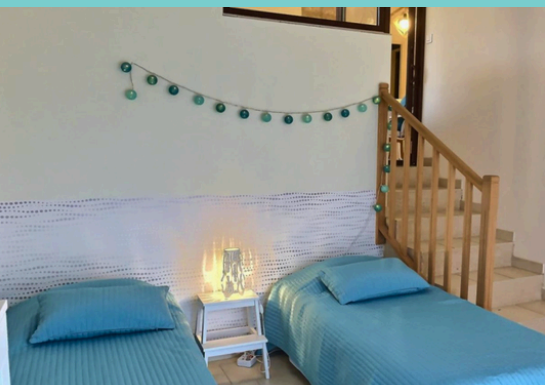

The accommodation features a cosy living area with a fully equipped kitchen, a fireplace, one double bedroom and a closed mezzanine sleeping area with 2 single beds. Outside, guests can enjoy a private garden with two terraces – one sunny and one shaded – as well as outdoor furniture and a barbecue.

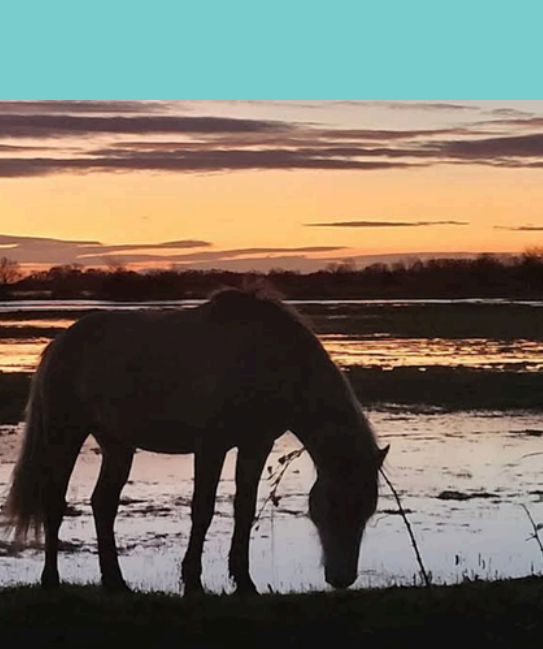
